Prayer Walking Guide Index:

1. Baptist Friendship House: Pray for the individual who come for services, pray our homeless participants, regular clients, and survivors of human trafficking. Pray for our staff and volunteers as they work to meet the physical, emotional, mental, and spiritual needs of all who walk through the doors.
2. Washington Square Park: Here there are a variety of ways to pray. Use the prayer guide prompts on homelessness, substance abuse, and poverty & hunger to guide your time while in the park.
3. Check Point Charlie: This area is a common hangout for homeless. Use the prayer guide prompts on homelessness and substance abuse to guide your prayers.
4. U.S. Mint: Again, this is a common hangout for homeless. Use the prayer guide prompts on homelessness and substance abuse to guide your prayers.
5. Hex Old-World Witchery: Voodoo and Witchcraft stores are a staple in New Orleans culture. Use the prayer walking guide prompt on witchcraft and voodoo to guide your prayer here.
6. French Market: The French Market is a unique open-air vendor market, within the market there is a mixture of nationalities, cultures, and religions. Also, many of the vendors embrace the voodoo and witchcraft culture. Use the prayer guide prompts Witchcraft & Voodoo to guide your prayer.
7. Jazz Park: This park is again a common area where homeless come to sit and hangout. Within the park many of the homeless who hangout uses either drugs or alcohol (or sometimes both). Use the prayer guide prompts on homelessness, substance abuse, and domestic violence to guide your prayers.
8. Moon Walk/Riverwalk: While at the Riverwalk take a moment to look over the French Quarter and prayer the city of New Orleans and all of her people. Also, you will again see homeless in the area so use the prompt to pray for the homeless.
9. Jackson Square: Often Tarot Card Readers set up around Jackson Square. Use the Tarot Card Reader prompt to pray as you walk around Jackson Square.
10. Reverend Zombie's House of Voodoo: Use the Voodoo & Witchcraft prompt to pray here.
11. Bourbon Street (*please know you DO NOT have to take your group down Bourbon St. if you are not comfortable. If you do prayer walk down Bourbon St., please use caution*): Bourbon Street is the most famous street in New Orleans and there are many ways to pray here. Use the prayer guide prompts for homelessness, substance abuse, crime, domestic violence, human trafficking, and poverty (many of the street performs especially the children/teens playing buckets, other instruments, or tapdancing live in poverty).
12. Exotic Dance Clubs: Human Trafficking is happening within many of the exotic dance clubs. Use the prayer guide prompt for human trafficking here.
13. 8th District Police Department: Pray for the crime in our city and for the safety of our law enforcement.
14. Harrah's Casino (*please know you do not have to walk all the way to Harrah's Casino*): Use the prayer guide prompt for gambling here.
15. Woldenberg Park: This park is another homeless hangout. Pray for the homeless who are here.
